This Indenture made and entered into this fifth day of October one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven between James M. Cross of Southampton City Va. of the first part James T. Moore of the same County and State of the same part and Abram Riddick of Stafford County N.C. of the third part; whereas the said James M. Cross Riddick's trustee is indebted to the said Abram Riddick in the sum of one hundred and five dollars thirty one cents, due by Bonds bearing date with this article which said the said Cross is willing and desires the payment of the said sum of money to the said Riddick and is also willing and desires to save him harmless and free from loss or damage by reason of his several engagements. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the promises and of the sum one dollar to him in hand paid by the said James T. Moore trustee hath given, granted, bargained and sold unto him the said Riddick the following property to wit, one bay Mare and colt which mare & foal I have this day sold and delivered to Abram Riddick for the purpose of paying off an execution against me in the hands of one Hill Constable of Giles City N.C. subject to be redeemed by paying the amount of the purchase money to said Riddick in thirty days otherwise the sale to be good to said Riddick my self of horse feed & feed, two beds & furniture, two trunks, five chairs 1/2 doz cups & saucers 1/2 doz plates, 2 stoves, four 1/2 doz knives & forks, bread-tray & wooden spade & 1/2 bushel measure 1 wood bucket 2 dishes, coffee pot & Milk & saddle & bridles, 2 plows & good looking utensils &c &c to him the said Jas T. Moore Trustee and his heirs forever. Upon trust nevertheless that the said Cross is to return possession of the said property until required by the said Riddick to sell thereupon the said James T. Moore trustee shall after advertising the time & place of sale sell the said property having conveyed and pay the said debt of one hundred and five dollars & 31/100 with the interest both &c. the balance of any of the money raised from such sale to be paid over to the said Cross. In testimony whereof the several parties have signed at their hands & seals the day and year before written.

This Indenture made and entered into this 30th day of January 1837. between Jacob Ramsay of the first part and Allen Harrison son of Benjamin Harrison of the second part, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Jacob Ramsay for and in consideration of the sum of fifty five dollars of lawful money to him in hand paid by the said Allen Harrison at or before signing & delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold & by these presents, sold, bargain & convey unto and to the said Allen Harrison all and singular right, title & interest in and to the said tract or lot of land known as the dower of Mary Battle formerly Mary Ramsay, it being a part of the land owned by M^{rs} Ramsay, and containing eighty nine acres or thereabouts more or less, of the said Jacob Ramsay, as hereby conveyed & makes over unto the said Allen Harrison all my right, title & interest in and to the said tract or lot of land free from the claim of one the said Ramsay & all & every other person or persons whatsoever.
