

act of the said County, did by Indenture of Trust convey to the said James Clayton his heirs Executors &c one certain tract or parcel of Land containing by estimation forty four acres, more or less; and whereas the said Thomas Turner has failed to pay and satisfy the aforesaid debt to the said John Moquhart; he the said John Moquhart hath therefore and execr'd the said James Clayton as trustee aforesaid to sacrifice and sell the said tract of Land for the purposes herein named, which the said James Clayton has promised to do - and has on this 11th day of August Eighteen hundred & thirty seven after duly advertising the same, sold to the highest bidder at public auction the tract of Land, one John Moquhart became the purchaser for the sum of Sixty five dollars, twenty five cents. Now this Indenture witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of Sixty five dollars, twenty five cents in hand paid by the said John Moquhart to the said James Clayton as trustee aforesaid at or before the sealing of these presents the rest whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained & sold at public auction to the said John Moquhart his heirs and assigns one certain tract of Land as aforesaid above and bounded by the lands of Robert Hart and Benjamin Brunfield reference being had well and fully advised, to have and to hold all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said John Moquhart his heirs and assigns forever, to and for the only proper use of him the said John Moquhart. And the said James Clayton as trustee doth for himself and his heirs the said forty four acres of Land with all & singular the premises herein conveyed to the said trustee unto the said John Moquhart his heirs and assigns forever free from the claim of him the said James Clayton as trustee or his heirs and shall warrant and forever defend by these presents. This Indenture made, executed and entered into this 7th day of October in the year of our Lord two thousand eight hundred and thirty seven between John P Boykin of Southampton County of the one part and Robert Hart of the same County of the other part witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred dollars to him in Land (prize or rewards to be paid by the said Robert Hart before the sealing) and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents with grant bargain and sell unto the said Robert Hart his heirs and assigns one certain tract of land or parcel of land wherein Joseph Bailey (formerly resides) situated, lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing by estimation three hundred acres to the same more or less, and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a white oak by the side of Sampson branch Thence West by South, sixteen poles to a pine a corner of Joseph Clemons land Thence by the said Clevens line, South eighty degrees West, one hundred & forty poles to a black gum a corner of Elizabeth Boykin's land Thence by the S E Baykin line north twenty five degrees east two hundred & fifty poles a black oak y more west by north thirty four poles to a pine a corner of Elizabeth Boykin by the side of the other branch Thence up the various courses of the said branch to a red oak Thence up the side Boykin's line N by E 30 degrees poles to a white oak Thence south Sixty five degrees east two hundred & eighty poles to a pine by the side of Sampson branch aforesaid and down the various courses of said branch to the beginning with all houses barns stables buildings yards gardens also with orchards lands tenements pastures woods water, watercourses priviledges, profits communitie advantages, emoluments hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract of land or parcel of land belonging or appertaining thereto and the rents issues and profits thereof and every part thereof. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned with all their rights members & appurtenances unto the said Robert Hart his heirs and assigns. And the said John P Boykin doth by these presents convey and transfer unto the said Robert Hart his heirs and assigns all the right and title which he the said John P Boykin the said tract or parcel of Land and premises and all and every person and persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents In witness whereof he the said John P Boykin hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the 7th
