This Indenture was acknowledged by Benjamin B. Blunt, party thereto to be his act and deed and admitted to record
and at a Court held for the said County the 28th day of November 1837 the said Indenture was entered upon the proceedings
of the day.

This Indenture made this thirtieth day of October in the year four thousand one thousand eight hundred
and thirty seven between Drury Bittle of the one party & Jefc Drewry of the other both of the County of Southampton
and State of Virginia. Whereas the said Drury Bittle is indebted to Benjamin B. Blunt of said County & State
Bank trustee in the sum of twelve hundred dollars by two bonds bearing date with these presents, in the sum of six hundred
dollars each, the one payable on the 30th day of October 1838 and the other payable on the 30th day of October
1839 the payment of which sums with interest from the above dates the said Drury Bittle is willing and desirous effectual
to secure to the said Benjamin B. Blunt. This Indenture therefore witnesseth that the said Drury Bittle
as well in consideration of the promises aforesaid as of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Jefc Drewry
the receipt whereof the said Drury Bittle doth hereby acknowledge, hath granted, bargained, sold and conveyed and
by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Jefc Drewry his heirs or assigns one certain
tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton and containing six hundred and eighty nine acres
the boundaries of which is laid down on a deed of bargain and sale from Benjamin B. Blunt to Drury Bittle
dated the 30th day of October 1837, with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging, to have and to
hold the said tract of Land and all appurtenances unto the said Jefc Drewry his heirs or assigns to his
proper use and behoof forever. I do trust nevertheless, that if the said Drury Bittle his heirs executors or
administrators shall owe or before the 30th day of October 1838 and truly pay to the said Benjamin B.
Blunt the sum of six hundred Dollars and owe or before the 30th day of October 1839 well and truly
pay to the said Benjamin B. Blunt the further sum of six hundred Dollars then this indenture to become
void; but if the said Drury Bittle shall fail to pay the above sums when they shall become due with cost
of creating this trust or any part thereof then the said Jefc Drewry his executors or administrators shall
and may sell and dispose of the aforesaid tract of land, where the said Benjamin B. Blunt or his assigns
may think proper to direct at public auction to the highest bidder for cash at the Court House, having
given at least twenty days notice at two or more public places in said County and by inserting the
same in some public newspaper printed in Norfolk or Petersburg; and that the proceeds of such sale after
paying thereout all the expenses attending the execution of this trust, shall be applied by the said Jefc Drewry
in part or towards the discharge of the aforesaid acts and the interest which may be due on the same and the
surplus of the said proceeds if any there shall be to be paid to the said Drury Bittle his heirs or assigns and in fur-
ther trust that until such sale shall be made, it shall be lawful to and for the said Drury Bittle his heirs to hold of
the said granted lands and receive the profits thereof and the said Drury Bittle for himself his heirs Executors &c with
holy warrant promise and grant to and with the said Jefc Drewry his heirs executors &c that he the said Drury
Bittle and his heirs shall and will warrant and defend the said lot of land with the appurtenances unto the
said Jefc Drewry his heirs or assigns, against all and every person or persons whatsoever claiming or to claim rights
title thereto or estate therein or any part thereof and that in case of a sale thereof for the purpose aforesaid
he the said Jefc Drewry his heirs executors &c shall and will on request execute a title to the purchase of said
lands and as all other things necessary to put him or them in actual possession of the same, and that the said Drury
Bittle his heirs executors &c will pay and discharge all taxes which may become payable for the said lands during
the time he may be in possession thereof or unless
whereof the said parties herein have to these presents set their hands and seals the day and year first in
this indenture written.
