This Indenture made and entered into this 8. day of November 1837 between Mary Williams (inward) of the first part and Theodore Tregvant of the second part all of the County of Southampton, Winchester that the said Mary Williams for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred & Twenty nine dollars & fifty cents to her in hand paid, the receipt whereof, is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained & sold and by this presents as grant bargain & sell unto the said Theodore Tregvant and his heirs and assigns forever, a certain tract or parcel of Land, lying in the County aforesaid, it being a portion of the Notaway Tribe of Indians, so called containing by estimation fifty one acre being the Lot No 5 as will more fully appear by reference to the Plot of said Lands allowed to me in fee simple by the Justice of the aforesaid tribe of Indians, bounded on the south by the lands of Lewis Maxwell with the reservation & provisions remainder & remainders rents and profits thereof To have and to hold, to the said Theodore Tregvant his heirs and assigns forever and the said Mary Williams for herself her heirs and assigns, hereby warrant and defend the title of the aforesaid tract of fifty one acre of Land to the said Theodore Tregvant his heirs & assigns forever. For and bounded as follows, say the following Lands Margaret Ballards, Jephthahsford Edwin Mallet and the Heirs of William Joyner decd. containing one hundred one ninety five acres. be the same more or less, to have and to hold the said Land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said Edwin Mallet his heirs and assigns forever, and the said William M. Robert doth covenant and agree with the said Edwin Mallet his heirs and assigns, well warrant and defend the aforesaid Land and premises unto him the said Edwin Mallet his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claim or claims of any person or persons whatsoever.
