Bishop to be in their own handwriting, whereupon the said writing is ordered that said deed be recorded.

This Indenture made and entered into the 22nd day of November 1837 between David Godwin of the first part, Almarine A. Deltt of the second part and Samuel P. Nicholson & Littleton R. Edwards, Amos Drury & Ethelred C. Briggs of the third part, all of the County of Southampton Aetatepeth, that whereas the said Samuel P. Nicholson & Littleton R. Edwards have become security for the said David Godwin in two delivery bonds one of the said bonds made payable to William H. Harvey and the other to Stephen Wardough owner of Handyside Edwards' deeds for the benefit of Anthony M. Howell - and the said Godwin also stands justly indebted unto Almarine P. Nicholson in the sum of fifty dollars by bond on demands the 23<sup>d</sup> day of November 1837 and to Bernard F. Briggs in the sum of Ninety eight & 7/100 dollars by bond due the 13<sup>d</sup> December 1837 & the further sum of two hundred & twelve dollars & fifteen dollars 95 cents by bond due the 24<sup>d</sup> November 1837, and the said David Godwin is anxious and desirous to secure & indemnify his aforesaid securities from all loss or damage whatever in consequence of their securityship for said and to secure the said Sam'l P. Nicholson & Bernard F. Briggs the sum of Money respectively set them forth for and in consideration of the promises aforesaid as well as for the further consideration of sum one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Almarine A. Deltt (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) granted, bargained & sold and by these presents do grant, bargain & sell unto the said Almarine A. Deltt, his executors & administrators, the following property to wit - One Bay Horse, one Buckskin or cream coloured Horse, one Barroch & Harness, one negro woman named Peggy, one mare left, 1 horsecart & wheels, 1 boat (litter one Bomanay Mill boat excepting) arms of glass 1 sofa & 3 upholstered chairs, 3 wash stands, pitched bowls, 8 feather beds and furniture, 1 side board, 1 tea table, 1 large mahogany table and all other articles of household furniture belonging to the said Godwin. To have and to hold the said property unto him the said Almarine A. Deltt his executors or administrators, to the end (so far as we and he of him the said Almarine A. Deltt his executors and administrators forever. Upon this special trust and confidence, that the said David Godwin is to be permitted to retain possession of the前述 property & the use and service therof to take what the said Samuel P. Nicholson, Littleton R. Edwards, Amos Drury & Ethelred C. Briggs or a majority of them shall think proper to order & use thereof, for the purpose of paying the debts aforesaid for which they are security, or until the said Loring T. Bishop & Bernard F. Briggs or either of them shall order a sale for the payment of the debts due them as aforesaid & the interest thereon. And upon this further trust, so soon as a sale shall be ordered as above provided for the said Almarine A. Deltt (or in case of his death for his legal personal representative who is hereby authorized to act) shall take full & effectual care of the said property hereinbefore conveyed, and giving reasonable public notice of the time & place of sale, sell at first public auction to the highest bidder for each the property aforesaid and with the monies arising from such sale first for all the necessary costs & expenses of such sale & this conveyance, then pay and satisfy the debts aforesaid for which the said Nicholson, Edwards, Drury & Briggs are securities and then pay & satisfy the debts hereinbefore mentioned to the said Nicholson & Bernard F. Briggs, and if any surplus should then remain pay the same to the said David Godwin his executors administrators or assigns.
