This Indenture made this 26th day of April 18 hundred and thirty seven between R. Blount of the County of Baldwin and State of Georgia of the one part, and John D. Turner of the County of Southampton and State of North Carolina of the other part; Witnesseth that the said R. Blount for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has bargained, sold, conveyed and confirmed and by these presents does bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said John D. Turner his heirs and assigns as certain tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia, Beginning at a bowl wood gum in the big Swash near Smith's big causway, thence down the middle of said Swash to a bygonny as corner in Smith & Jones's land, thence easterly along Jones's line to a gum corner in the Swamp, thence up the middle of said Swamp, and a Branch to an oak corner, thence to a pine corner at Jones's fence, thence northerly a straight line to an oak corner on Nathan Popps line, thence westerly to John Halehead's line, thence down the meadow and end a branch to a lane, a spot line to a gum at the beginning, containing two hundred acres, more or less, To have and to hold the said bargained land and premises with all their appurtenances of every kind whatsoever unto the said John D. Turner his heirs and assigns forever. And the said R. Blount for himself, his heirs and assigns does hereby covenant and agree to warrant and defend the right and title to the said bargained land, unto the said John D. Turner his heirs and assigns against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons other claiming this therein in any manner whatsoever.
