

page 2 on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of December 1838 (w<sup>th</sup>) by th<sup>e</sup> said Joseph Barkham to the said Peter Edwards,  
 conveyed in trust to the said Robert J. Musgrave and a certain tract of land situated in the County and State  
 aforesaid it being the tract of land which the said Joseph Barkham purchased of the said Peter Edwards, and the said sum  
 all sums of money, having been fully paid by the said Joseph Barkham to the said Peter Edwards by the said Joseph  
 Barkham, hath requested that the estate conveyed by the said deeds of trust to them the said Robert J. Musgrave and  
 Peter Edwards on the said lands be now released to him the said Joseph Barkham—This Indenture therefore witnesseth  
 That for and in consideration of the premises, and also for and in consideration of one Dollar by the said Joseph Barkham  
 to the said J<sup>e</sup>ff<sup>e</sup> Drewry specially appointed Trustee as aforesaid in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of  
 these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said J<sup>e</sup>ff<sup>e</sup> Drewry, with the assent of the Peter  
 Edwards, signified by his being a party hereto, have granted, remised, released and forever quit claimed, and by these  
 presents, is fully and absolutely granted, remised, released and forever quit claimant unto the said Joseph Barkham  
 his heirs and assigns forever all the estate, right, title, interest, property, claim and demand whatsoever, in law  
 or equity, of them and each of them the said J<sup>e</sup>ff<sup>e</sup> Drewry and Peter Edwards of, in and to the aforesaid tract  
 of lands with the appurtenances. To have and to hold the aforesaid lot of ground with its appurtenances, to  
 the said Joseph Barkham his heirs and assigns to the only use and behoof of the said Joseph Barkham his heirs  
 and assigns forever, so that the said J<sup>e</sup>ff<sup>e</sup> Drewry or Peter Edwards nor either of them nor their heirs shall  
 have claim or demand in or to the said premises. In witness whereof the parties of the first and second parts

This Indenture made and entered into this the day of 1837 between Joseph Barkham

Barkham and Jennet his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Drewry Bittle of the  
 same County and State of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Joseph Barkham and Jennet his wife for  
 and in consideration of the sum of Thirteen hundred dollars to the said Joseph Barkham in hand paid by the  
 said Drewry Bittle the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given, granted, bargained and sold and  
 Exempted by these presents do give grant bargain sell unto the said Drewry Bittle and his heirs and assigns one or  
 more tracts or parcels of land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid containing four hundred  
 acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows, on the North the land belonging to Drewry Bittle and  
 Aug. 26/1841 George Blunt on the west by the lands of Drewry Bittle and Nathaniel Francis and the lands belonging to  
 the King and Queen Estate of Benjamin Edwards and on the south by the lands of Elsho Atkinson and James Powell and a  
 part of which lies to the east by the lands of James Powell and George Blunt it being the land that the said Joseph Barkham for  
 the sum of £54 chartered of Peter Edwards with all the privileges improvements and appurtenances thereto belonging save and  
 in due Proportion except one half acre of land including and surrounding the family burying grounds. To have and to hold to the  
 said Drewry Bittle his heirs and assigns forever, the aforesaid tract of land containing four hundred acres more or  
 less with the above named exceptions, against the claim of them the said Joseph Barkham and Jennet his wife  
 of all and every person or persons whatsoever. In witness whereof the said Joseph Barkham and Jennet his wife  
 hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and year above mentioned.
