This Indenture therefore witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises, and also for and in consideration of one Dollar by the said Joseph Barham to the said Jesse Drewry specially appointed trustee as aforesaid in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Jesse Drewry, with the assent of the said Peter Edwards, signified by his being a party hereto, have granted, remised, released and forever quit claimed, and by these presents, as fully and absolutely grant, remise, release and forever quit claim unto the said Joseph Barham his heirs and assigns forever all the estate, right, title, interest, property, claim and demand whatsoever, in law or equity, of them and each of them the said Jesse Drewry and Peter Edwards of, in and to the aforesaid tract of Land with the appurtenances. To have and to hold the aforesaid lot of grounds with its appurtenances, to the said Joseph Barham his heirs and assigns to the only use and behoof of the said Joseph Barham his heirs and assigns forever, so that the said Jesse Drewry or Peter Edwards nor either of them nor their heirs shall have claim or demand in or to the said premises. This Indenture made and entered into this the _____ day of _____ 1837 between Joseph Barham and Jennet his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Drewry Billie of the same County and State of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Joseph Barham and Jennet his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Thirteen hundred dollars to the said Joseph Barham in hand paid by the said Drewry Billie the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given, granted bargained and sold unto the said Drewry Billie and his heirs and assigns forever by these presents as full grant bargain sell unto the said Drewry Billie and his heirs and assigns forever all that certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, containing four hundred acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows, on the North by the Land belonging to Drewry Billie and Aug. 26/1841 being Blunt on the west by the Lands of Drewry Billie and Nathaniel Frances and the Lands belonging to the distinguished estate of Benjamin Edwards and on the south by the lands of Charles Atkinson and James Powell and on the east by the Lands of James Powell and George Blunt it being the land that the said Joseph Barham for his wife Jennet purchased of Peter Edwards with all the privileges improvements and appurtenances thereto belonging save and except one-half acre of land including and surrounding the family burying ground. To have and to hold to the said Drewry Billie his heirs and assigns forever, the aforesaid tract of Land containing four hundred acres more or less with the above named exceptions, against the claim of them the said Joseph Barham and Jennet, his wife and every person or persons whatsoever.
