This Indenture made this twenty second day of November One thousand eight hundred and thirteen  
between Dowry Bittle of the County of Southampton of the one part and Jofe Drewry of the said County  
of the other part. Whereas the said Dowry Bittle is indebted to Peter Edwards, in the sum of One thousand  
two hundred and Nineteen dollars and Thirty six cents by bond bearing equal date with these presents,  
to James L Taylor in the sum of One hundred and Ninety eight Dollars and Ten cents by bond due March  
thirteen thousand eight hundred and thirty seven, and whereas John Ivory has this day become security  
for the said Dowry Bittle to all bonds executed to Jofe Drewry for the sum of Three hundred and one  
Hundred and Seventy one cents bearing equal date with these presents: the payment of which sums with lawfull  
interest thereon from their several dates, the said Dowry Bittle is willing and desirous effectually to secure to the  
said Peter Edwards & James L Taylor and further to secure the said John Ivory as security as aforesaid. This Indenture  
witnesseth, that the said Dowry Bittle, as well in consideration of the promises aforesaid, as of one dollar to him in  
hand paid by the said Jofe Drewry the receipt whereof the said Dowry Bittle doth hereby acknowledge,  
hath granted bargained and sold unto the said Jofe Drewry his heirs or assigns,  
one tract of land containing four hundred acres, more or less, and bounded by the banks of Northam River  
and the Blant tract on the West, and the lands of the Blant tract on the north, on the east by the lands of Benjamin  
Edwards decd. on the S. by the lands of Eliza Pittman decd. and James Powell - which lands said Dowry Bittle  
purchased of Joseph Barnham. One other tract of Land purchased by said Dowry Bittle of Benjamin Blant supposed  
to contain six hundred and sixty acres, more or less, which tract of Land is conveyed to Jofe Drewry trustee to secure  
a debt due Benjamin Blant which debt is of record in the Deeds Office - Southampton County, one Negro Girl, Nancy,  
one Negro boy, Billy, one boy Jofe & Boy Henry, with all and singularly the houses, buildings and other improp-  
erty thereto belonging or appertaining, and all the right title and estate of the said Dowry Bittle therein, as  
also the revenue and reversions, remainders and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof together with the negro slaves  
herein named. To have and to hold the said lots of Land, with the premises and appurtenances together with  
the negro slaves aforesaid unto the said Jofe Drewry his heirs and assigns and to their posterity and behoof: And  
trust neverthelss that the said Dowry Bittle, his heirs executors or administrators, shall when required, well and  
truly pay to the said Peter Edwards & James Turner and release the said John Ivory from the security ship  
aforesaid by paying the amount of said bonds with legal interest thereon, and all costs attending this trust  
then this indenture, and every thing herein contained is to become void; but if the said several sums of mon-  
ey shall not be paid on application the said Jofe Drewry his heirs or assigns shall and may dispose of the  
aforenamed tract of land, and the negro slaves aforesaid at public auction to the highest bidder for cash at  
the long Reys on the County of Southampton after giving twenty days notice at three or more public places  
in the said County, of the time and place of sale, and that the proceeds of such sale after paying thereout all  
the expenses attending the execution of this trust shall be applied by the said Jofe Drewry his heirs or as-  
signs towards the discharge and payment of the aforesaid debts with the interest which may be due thereon  
and the surplus of proceeds, if any, pay to the said Dowry Bittle or his assigns. And the said Dowry Bittle  
for himself, his heirs executors and administrators, doth hereby covenant, promise and grant to and with the said  
Jofe Drewry and his heirs, shall and will warrant and forever defend the said lots of Land and all the premises,  
with the negro slaves aforesaid unto the said Jofe Drewry his heirs and assigns against all and every person or  
persons whomsoever claiming or to claim, right title, interest or estate therein or in any part thereof; and  
that in case of a sale thereof, for the purpose aforesaid, he the said Jofe Drewry his heirs or assigns, shall  
and will on request, do all such acts or things and make and lawfully execute all such deeds as may be re-  
quired, for fulfilling the purposed in article preceding of the aforesaid prospectus. In witness whereof the  
parties hereunto have to these presents set their hands and sealed the day and year first in this indenture written.
