Witnesseth that the said Rich Drewry for an consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Jas Nick at or before the recording of delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, as well as the further consideration of the said Richard Drewry being justly indebted to the sd. John Nick in the just and full sum of thirty dollars and 80 cent at this time by bond and the same obligations to be binding for all bonds or acts which may be justly due at the time when we settle or when the said John Nick is paid off from the sales of the said property, in lawful money with lawful interest thereon. Witnesseth that the sd. Richard Drewry is willing to secure the sd. John Nick, which is the sole object of these presents, hath granted, bargained, sold and conveyed unto the sd. Jas Nick his heirs executors or assigns, one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation one hundred and fifty acres, and bounded as follows on the north to Joseph Parker's land, on the east by John Broadbush's land on the south by John Drewry's land on the west the same. I also convey all my lots of land & fields which I make in 1837 my household furniture I beds and furniture kitchen utensils &c I convey unto the said James Nick his heirs Executors or assigns upon being requested by the said John Nick his heirs or assigns shall make sale of the above mentioned Land and Property at publick for the best price that can be obtained after the 15th day of May 1837 after advertising the same at the most publick places, ten days previous to the day of sale and with the money so paid the said John Nick all his just claims with lawful interest thereon and all cost which may occur in making sale of the same and then pay the overplus if any to the said Richard Drewry. And the said Richard Drewry for himself his heirs and assigns do warrant the rights of the aforesaid lands & property with the appurtenances thereto unto the sd. James Nick his heirs and assigns for the purpose aforesaid as warrant and forever defend against any lawful claim or demand whatsoever claiming or commanding the same or any part thereof. And the said James Nick for himself his heirs or assigns do agree to make sale of the above mentioned property and land any time when requested by the sd. John Nick his heirs Executors or assigns.
