This Indenture made and entered into this 18th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven between Joseph T. Coland Sam'l Drewry, (Now J. Jones & Nathaniel Francis Commissioners sent eight hundred and thirty seven between Joseph T. Coland Sam'l Drewry, (Now J. Jones & Nathaniel Francis Commissioners appointed by the Court of Southampton at the November Court 1837) of the said County and State of Virginia of the one part and Peter D. Beckman of the said County & State of the other part witnesseth this for and in consideration of the sum of two thousand four hundred & fifteen the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Commissioners, hath by the direction of said Court granted bargained and sold and by these presents so grant bargain & sell unto the said Peter D. Beckman his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances, situate, lying and being in the aforesaid County which land the late Jonathan Beckman alias Beck and his wife known by the name of Beck's tract containing Four hundred & fifty acres by the same more or less and bounded as follows on the north by the lands of Stephen Williams, on the east by the lands of James Miller and Francis Ridley on the south by the lands of Capt. Lewis Morris and on the west by the lands William Jenkins and Content Jenkins of which said land are the said Joseph T. Coland, Sam'l Drewry, William J. Jones & Nathaniel Francis as Commissioners so warrant the rights and title unto the said Peter D. Beckman his heirs and assigns forever. This Indenture made this 18th day of December 1837 between Sam'l Hines & Harry Bull Commissioners appointed by a Court of the County Court of Southampton November - - 1837 to sell the land of John Smith and of the one part and Sam'l J. James of the other part all of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Commissioners for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and Fifty one dollars to them in hand paid by the said James. Then the sd Commissioners, S. B. Hines & Harry Bull (in presence of the said James) have granted bargained & sold unto the said Sam'l J. James and by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said James his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton and containing by estimation one hundred acres by the same, more or less and bounded as follows to wit by the lands of James Bunnell, Henry Bowman and Susan Hines, Sam'l J. James & Richl Hines. Together with all singulars the promises and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any way appertaining and every part of parcel thereof. To have & to hold the said one hundred acres of land more or less with the tenements hereditaments and all singulars thereto the promises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained & sold, and every part & parcel thereof unto all and every of their right & members appurtenances unto the said Sam'l J. James his heirs & assigns forever. To and for the only purpose and intent of him the said Sam'l J. James his heirs & assigns forever and the said Commissioners by virtue of the power vested in them by the aforesaid decree, for themselves & their heirs the sd one hundred acres of land with all and singular the promises and appurtenances, before mentioned unto the said Sam'l J. James his heirs & assigns free from all claims & claims of them the sd Commissioners at either of them their heirs or either of their heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall well and as warrant and forever defend by these presents. In witness whereof we the said Sam'l B. Hines, Richl Hines & Harry Bull Commissioners aforesaid have hereunto set our hands & affix'd seals this day and year first above written.
