Pittow in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Robert Pittow which is hereby acknowledged both given, granted, bargained and sold and by these presents with give, grant, bargain & sell unto the said Robert Pittow his heirs and assigns forever a parcel of land lying in the State of Blackwater and Copperhock Mill Run in Southampton County containing by late Survey one hundred and twenty seven acres also forty two and 3/4 acres of said (part of and adjoining) the above mentioned land. To have and to hold the said land together with its appurtenances to him the said Robert Pittow his heirs forever and the said Anselm B. Pittow his heirs executors and assigns forever.
