Witnesseth that the said Anselon P. Pittlow in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given, granted, bargained and sold and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain & sell unto the said Robert Pittlow his heirs and & one certain tract of land lying in the parts of Blackwater and Upperhanks Mill Run in Southampton County containing by late Survey, two hundred and twenty seven acres also forty two and 3/4 acres of Land (part of and adjoining) the above mentioned land. To have and to hold the said land together with its appurtenances to him the said Robert Pittlow his heirs forever and the said Anselon P. Pittlow his heirs executors and administrators of the said tract or parcels of Land to him the said Robert Pittlow his heirs and assigns shall and will forever warrant and defend.
