The Indenture made and entered into this 17th day June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven between Dixon Bradshaw of the first part, Thomas J. Broster of the second part and James E. Clayton of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Whereas that the said Dixon Bradshaw for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty one dollars & ninety five cents which said sum is due from the said Dixon Bradshaw to the said James E. Clayton by bond bearing date the 17th day of June One Thousand Eight hundred and Thirty seven as well as all other monies which may be due and owing from the said Dixon Bradshaw to the said James E. Clayton by means of any dealing transferred of debt or paper whatsoever, is also due and in consideration of one dollar, a sum in hand paid by the said Thomas J. Broster. The receipt whereof the said Dixon Bradshaw doth hereby acknowledge, hath granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents doth hereby grant, bargain and sell convey and make over unto the said James E. Clayton and his heirs forever all his right and interest in the following property to wit: Eight head of sheep, three cows and one calf and their future increase and two hens & piggies belonging to the said Dixon Bradshaw. To have and to hold with all the right and interest of the said Dixon Bradshaw, however created, or intended to be conveyed to him the said Thomas J. Broster his heirs and assigns forever. Upon this special trust notwithstanding that the said Thomas J. Broster upon being thereto required by the aforesaid James E. Clayton, shall proceed to sell all the rights and interest of the said Dixon Bradshaw to the above named property hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed after advertising the time and place in the County of Southampton for ten days previous, at some public house or store for debts and out of the money arising out of or from the said sale, in the parish place pay and satisfy all cost attending the said sale as well as the expenses attending this conveyance and then pay off the bonds aforesaid with interest, as well as other monies which may appear to be due and owing from the said Dixon Bradshaw to the said James E. Clayton by means of any dealing transferred of debt or paper whatsoever and the surplus, if any, pay to the said Dixon Bradshaw, and the said Dixon Bradshaw his heirs executors and administrators the right and title of the said property unto the said Thomas J. Broster his heirs and assigns forever as to hereby warrant and defend against the lawful claim or claims of him the said Dixon Bradshaw his heirs, executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever; and the said Thomas J. Broster on his part covenants and agrees that he will make sale of the right and interest, conveyed for the best price he can obtain for the same after advertising the time and place for ten days previous at some public house or store in the said County and with monies arising from the sale first pay and satisfy all cost attending the same as well as the expense attending this conveyance and then pay off the aforesaid bonds and interest as well as all other monies which may appear to the said Thomas J. Broster to be due and owing from the said Dixon Bradshaw to the said James E. Clayton by means of any dealing transferred of debt or paper whatsoever, and pay the overplus, if any, to the said Dixon Bradshaw; and the said Thomas J. Broster on his part covenants and agrees that he will release the said property from the obligation of the incumbrance upon the said Dixon Bradshaw paying him the amount of the aforesaid bonds with interest as well as all other monies which may be due and owing to him from the said Dixon Bradshaw by means of any dealing transferred of debt or paper whatsoever.
