This Indenture made and entered into this 25th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Thirty seven between Susan Shepherd widow of John Shepherd deceased of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and Ryord Lunday of the County and State of Virginia of the second part, whereas by his deed dated on the fifteenth day of March one thousand eight hundred and thirty three, and admitted to record in the Clerk's Office of the said County, the said John Shepherd in his lifetime granted and conveyed to one Benjamin Lewis in trust for the use and benefit of the said Susan his wife, for her life and the tract of land and appurtenances purchased by him of Edwin B. Claude situated in the County of Southampton - and whereas by his last will which he has been duly admitted to record by the County Courts of the County of Southampton the said John Shepherd devised to the said Susan all his estate real and personal, for her life and at her death, to such person or persons as she might dispose thereof to - Now This Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand four hundred and eleven dollars to her to be received to be paid by the said Ryord Lunday, for the sealing and delivery of these presents, which is hereby acknowledged, the said Susan Shepherd hath granted, bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Ryord Lunday, the tract of land aforesaid, situated in the County of Southampton and containing one hundred and ninety two acres, more or less, and bounded as described in the deed from the said Edwin B. Claude, of record in the Clerk's Office of the County of Southampton: also a small parcel of Land with the appurtenances, situate in the County of Southampton, containing the tract aforesaid, bounded by the same, and by the lands of James Drewry and Edwin B. Claude, suppose certain fifteen acres be the same more or less. To have and to hold the said two tracts of Land with the appurtenances, to him the said Ryord Lunday and to his heirs and assigns, and to his and their only, use and behoof absolute, free and simple estate forever; and the said Susan Shepherd for herself, and her heirs, covenants with the said Ryord Lunday his heirs and assigns that she will forever warrant and defend to him and them a good and perfect title to the said tracts of Land with the appurtenances against the claim of all persons whatsoever.

This Indenture made and entered into on this 25th day of December in the year of our Lord Eighty nine hundred and Thirty seven between Julia Gwaltney of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, of the one part and Henry Jones of the same County and State of the other part. Whereas that the said Julia Gwaltney for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars and twenty five cents of this Commonwealth to her in hand paid by the said Henry Jones at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, sold aliened enfeoffed and delivered and by these presents with grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm

unto him the said Henry Jones his heirs and assigns forever an undivided half interest in the tract of land, or parcels of land, situated, lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parcels of land therein containing by estimation forty five acres (to the same more or less) it being the tract or parcels of land on which said Julia Gwaltney now resides which was devised to her by the last will and testament of her husband Gwaltney aforesaid and bounded by the same of the said Henry Jones, William Gwaltney her John Gwaltney his
