This Indenture made and entered into the eighth day of July in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven between Thomas F. Brown, William Parker & Howell A. Atkins of the County of Sussex (Commissioners acting under a Decree of the County Court of Southampton for the sale of the lands belonging to the heirs of J. & S. Hines of the fourth part of Sussex Hines of the County of Southampton, of the second part: Witnesseth that the aforesaid Thomas F. Brown, William Parker and Howell A. Atkins Commissioners (acting under the aforesaid decree) for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and thirty three dollars to us in hand paid by the said Susan Hines the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have (so far as the right is conferred on us as Commissioners acting under the aforesaid decree) granted bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain sell, alien convey and confirm unto the said Susan Hines and to her heirs and assigns forever, two tracts or parcels of lands; the one situate lying & being in the County of Southampton and bounded on the North by the lands of Samuel B. Hines, on the east by the lands of Isaac Hines on the South by the lands of John Paines and on the West by the Road leading from Jerusalem to Petersburg, which separates it from the lands of Elizabeth Hitchens and Henry Freeman and containing four acres, be the same more or less. The other tract situate lying and being in the County of Sussex bounded on the North and east by the lands of Samuel B. Hines and Henry Freeman & on the south and west by the lands of James Scammon and Susan Hines and containing thirty acres, be the same more or less together with all the hereditaments & appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion or reversions, remainders or remainders, rents and profits thereof: and all the estate right title interest claim & demand whatsoever of the said Commissioners either in Law or Equity of in & to the above bargained premises with the said hereditaments and appurtenances. To have and to hold the said premises above mentioned and described to the said Susan Hines her heirs and assigns to the sole use and behoof of her the said Susan Hines her heirs and assigns forever. And the said Commissioners for the heirs of the aforesaid Frederick T. Hines do grant convey and agree to and with the said Susan Hines her heirs and assigns the above bargained premises in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said Susan Hines her heirs and assigns against all who ever or persons Lawfully and Equitably claiming or to claim the whole or any part thereof. Hise of the County of Sussex, Peria County & State of Illinois of the one part and Dr. H. D. De Haven of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Jesse J. Cox & Benjamin R. Hise for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said Peter C. De Haven his heirs and assigns forever all their right title & interest to a certain piece of land situate and lying in the County of Southampton & State of Virginia better known by the name "Long Pond" containing fifteen acres more or less, bounded as follows by the lands of J. Williams, Thomas R. Hise & others together
