Lawrence this day bargained & sold & do hereby transfer & convey to Mills & Lawrence and his heirs for the consideration of four hundred & forty nine dollars to me, John, a tract or parcel of land in the County of Southampton in the state of N.Y. containing by estimation two hundred and one be the same more or less & bounded by the lands of John Urquhart, & John Boykin & Blackwater River.
