Know all men by these presents that we Harrison Moore Elisha & Edwin Harrison are held and firmly bound unto David Campbell Esq; Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia on the just and full sum of Two Thousand dollars, to be paid to the said Governor and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth for the payment whereof well and truly to be made we bind ourselves and each of us our and each of our heirs executors and administrators jointly and severally for by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated this 19th day of February 1838.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Harrison Moore has been duly appointed by the Court of Southampton County to serve as constable with the said County to supply the vacancy created by the resignation of William Atkinson. Now if the said Harrison Moore shall well and truly discharge the duties of the office of constable in the said County during his continuance therein then this obligation to be void is else to remain in full force and virtue!

This indenture made and entered into this the 1st day of January in the year 1838 between William Williams and Alice B. his Wife, of the one part and Jeptha Little of the other part, all of the County of Southampton to witness that the said William S. Williams and Alice B. his Wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Jeptha Little at or before the concluding and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and confirm unto the said Jeptha Little his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid bounded as follows, to wit, beginning at a Sycamore oak at side like in Joseph Drury's line, running thence a South West course to a Post sycamore tree, fore and aft, thence a straight line to a black gum a new made corner tree in a small branch, thence the said William S. Williams & Jeptha Little, thence down the said Branch to a White oak a corner between Jeptha Little & Samuel James thence up the said branch & bounded by the lands of Samuel James & Reuben Barker to a corner between the land hereby sold by Susanna Cobb, a black gum, thence a straight line to a White oak, a corner for Joseph Drury & Jeptha Little in Mrs Cobb's land, thence a South course to a corner point for the said land and Joseph Drury, thence a straight line to the beginning containing by estimation one hundred acres be the same more or less, with all and singular the premises and appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of land belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and premises with every of its appurtenances unto him the said Jeptha Little his heirs and assigns forever. And the said William S. Williams & Alice B. his Wife for themselves their heirs executors and administrators hereby covenant with the said Jeptha Little his heirs and assigns that will warrant defend the title to the land hereby conveyed unto him the said Jeptha Little his heirs and assigns against the claim of themselves the said William S. Williams and Alice B. his Wife and of every other person or persons whatever. In testimony whereof the said William S. Williams and Alice B. his Wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and year before written.
