

This Indenture made this 15th day of December in the year of Christ Eighteen hundred and Thirty seven
between Thomas Fitzhugh and Rebecca his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, of the one part,
and Thomas Ridley Jr of sd County and State of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Fitzhugh conferre and in con-
sideration of the sum of one dollar lawful money of the United States to him by the said Thomas Ridley in hand paid
to him whereof the said Fitzhugh and wife do hereby acknowledge hath granted, bargained and sold and by these
presente do grant, bargain sell and convey unto the said Thomas Ridley, his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or
parcel of Land, containing by estimation four hundred and fifty four acres, lie the same more or less, lying and being
in the County of Southampton and known by the name of Roberts old place, being the same which was inhered
by the late Samuel Blunt Sr. to his son Samuel Blunt and conveyed by sp Samuel Blunt Jr to Thomas Fitzhugh,
as will more fully appear by reference to the will of the said Samuel Blunt Sr, and a deed of bargain and sale executed
delivered by Samuel Blunt Jr dated the 3rd day of December 1834 both of record in the Clerks Office of the County
Court of Southampton, being on Buckhorn Swamp, and adjoining the lands of George P. A. Newson, Thomas Ridley,
Isaac Kendall and others. To have and to hold the sd. tract or parcel of Land, with the appurtenances thereto belong-
ing, to him the said Thomas Ridley Jr his heirs and assigns to the only, proper use and behoof of the said Thos.
Ridley his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Thomas Fitzhugh & Rebecca his wife for themselves, their heirs,
executors and administrators, do hereby warrant and agree to and with the said Thomas Ridley his heirs and assigns,
that they the said Fitzhugh and wife and their heirs the said tract, a parcel of Land with its appurtenances, unto
him the said Thomas Ridley his heirs and assigns ^{and them the said Fitzhugh and his/her heirs and assigns}, shall and will, by these
presente, forever warrant and defend. In witness whereof the said Thomas Fitzhugh and Rebecca, his wife,
have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals, the day & year above written.

This Indenture made and entered into this 13th day of October in the year of Christ Eighteen
hundred and thirty seven between Nathaniel DeLand and Mary H. Land of the County of Suffolk and Samuel
Basham of the County of Southampton and all of the state of Virginia: Witnesseth that the said Nathaniel D.
DeLand and Mary H. Land, his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars and — cents lawful
money of Virginia, to them on hands paid, the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge, they the said Nathaniel
DeLand and Mary H. Land, his wife, have granted, bargained and sold and by this indenture do grants, bargain
and sell, alien, release and confirm unto the said Samuel Basham and to his heirs and assigns forever, one cer-
tain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing one hundred acres be-
ing the same more or less, and bounded North by the lands belonging to the Heirs of Nathaniel Rechell - East by
the lands of Robert Roebell - South by the lands of Samuel Basham and west by the lands of John A.
Hillman. To have and to hold the above granted premises, with all and singular the appurtenances there-
unto belonging or in any wise appertaining. To the only proper use and behoof of him the said Samuel Basham.
