Ferguson of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the first part and Caswell C. Ferguson of the County of Hertford in the State of North Carolina, of the second part, This indenture whereby the said Colleen J. Ferguson have, for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Caswell C. Ferguson at the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold unto by these presents doth hereby grant bargain and sell unto him the said Caswell C. Ferguson all the right, title, interest and estate which he the said Colleen J. Ferguson now has or ever may hereafter have in and to the lands and Slaves of which his father Deacon Ferguson of the said County of Southampton is deceased and possessed. To have and to hold the said interest in so full extent, as to the free simple estate therein to him the said Caswell C. Ferguson his heirs and assigns forever free from the claim of him the said Colleen J. Ferguson his heirs and assigns, and also free from the claim of all and every person and persons whomsoever, hereby in like manner warranting and defending the title of in and to the said interest in said lands and Slaves to him the said Caswell C. Ferguson his heirs and assigns forever against the claim of himself, his heirs and assigns and also against the claim of all and every person and persons whomsoever. This Indenture made this 12th day of September one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven between Thomas Drumwright, trustee of a deed from Albert Andrews of the one part and Henry Ellis of the other part, This indenture whereby the sum of one hundred and thirty-four dollars to the said Drumwright, trustee in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold to the said Henry Ellis, his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton Va. containing 25 1/2 acres to the same more or less bounded as follows as follows (V.S.B. beginning) at the fork of Roady, held branch just below the old Mill dam thence up said branch to George Harris's line thence along said Harris's line to Walter B. Brattle's line thence along said Brattle's line to a small shack or branch that leads from the long pond to Roady held branch thence down said branch to the spring. To have and to hold the said tract of land to him the said Henry Ellis his heirs or assigns to their proper use and behoof until Alfred J. Brattle shall become suffering through or by the maladministration of Albert Andrews some of Anthony, James and at which time said Brattle may sell the said tract of land under and after deed executed to Roberton Arch.
