Situate lying and being in the County of Southampton ten containing eighty acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows (to wit) on the north by the main part of the Swamp on the east by the main part of the said Swamp on the west by the lands belonging to the said James C Peters and Joseph H Parker, and on the south by the land of said Peters and Joseph Parker, to which reversionary rights title &c the said Joseph H Barkham and Solomon J Barkham do warrant and forever defend the title of the said Peters and his heirs and assigns forever against the claims of every person whatsoever.
