This Indenture made this 10th day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight between Lemuel Andrews of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Joseph Hart of the same County & Parish of the other part, witnesseth that, the said Lemuel Andrews for and in consideration of the sum of ninety dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid or secured by the said Joseph Hart, the receipt whereof the said Lemuel Andrews doth acknowledge himself fully and amply satisfied and paid, hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Joseph Hart his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land and premises situate lying in the County aforesaid containing by a late survey 305 acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows, (to wit,) beginning at a small spine corner in Thomas Hart's line thence to the large path, thence to a small meadow, corner in Ponds line thence to a post or stob on stob, thence to a small black gum to the head of land which down said ditch to a small black gum, thence to a small safford corner in Washington's line thence to the beginning or first station. Together with all houses out houses, outhouses, buildings, yards, gardens, orchards, ways, waters, watercourses, wharves belonging or in any manner appertaining thereto. To have and to hold the said land and premises to him and to his heirs forever. And the said Lemuel Andrews for himself his heirs &c with by these presents covenants grants to and with the said Joseph Hart his heirs &c signifies that he will by these presents warrant and forever quit all right title claim or demands of any person or persons whatsoever claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof. This Indenture made this 21st day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight between Simon J. Westbrook of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Joseph T. Cleaves of the said County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Simon J. Westbrook for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars of lawful money of the Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said Joseph T. Cleaves at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Joseph T. Cleaves his heirs and assigns forever, a certain tract or parcel of land situated and being in the County of Southampton, at the south side of the tract on which the said Westbrook now resides or, containing by estimation one hundred acres, be the same more or less, and bounded as followeth, to wit, beginning at the said Cleaves land at the Gum swamp and thence along the said swamp to the tract of land belonging to the Orphans of York, Westbrooks, and thence along down the swamp to the said Cleaves line again. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land, together with all the appurtenances belonging or in any wise appertaining and all the privileges to and for the only proper use of him the said Joseph T. Cleaves his heirs and assigns forever, all the interest and rights that, if, the said Simon J. Westbrook may have in the said tract or parcel of Land, I do warrant and forever assign unto him the said Joseph T. Cleaves his heirs and assigns forever for In witness whereof the said Simon J.
