Whereas the said Robert Gilliom is hereby indebted to the said Clements Rochelle in the sum of twenty dollars or thereabouts due by note dated sometime in June 1836 which said note with legal interest thereon, the said Robt. Gilliom is willing and desirous to secure now this indenture unto forth that for and in consideration of one dollar to the said Robt. Gilliom in hand paid by the said James Maggs at and before the sealing & delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Robt. Gilliom hath given, granted bargained & sold to the said James Maggs (trustee) the following property to wit one horse aged 8 years and one cart, wheels &c. to have and to hold the said grantee personal property hereby conveyed unto the said James Maggs his heirs & assigns forever. And the said Robt. Gilliom for himself his heirs, execs. adms. and assigns acknowledge and to and with the said James Maggs his heirs & assigns in manner and form following that his son Robert Gilliom his heirs, execs & assigns will forever hold & keep the said horse & cart, wheels &c unto the said James Maggs his heirs & assigns against all persons whatever will forever warrant and defend by these presents
