

13 1/2 C. 17 poles, to said George B. Corry's corner. Williams is willing) and desirous to secure now this indenture whereby that for and in consideration of one dollar to the said Robt. Williams in hand paid by the said James Magh at and before the sealing & delivery of these presents, the facts whereof is hereby acknowledged, be the said Robt. Williams hath given, granted, bargained & sold to the said James Magh (trustee) the following property to wit: One Sorrell horse aged 8 years and one cart, wheels &c. to have and to hold the said granted person's property hereby conveyed unto the said James Magh, his heirs & assigns forever. And the said Robt. Williams for himself, his heirs, executors, assigns and assigns do hereby covenant to and with the said James Magh his heirs & assigns in manner and form following, That whereas Robert Williams his heirs, executors &c. therefore owe horse & cart, wheels &c. unto the said James Magh his heirs & assigns against all persons whatsoever will forever warrant and defend by these presents
