This Indenture made & entered into this, the 20th day of March 1838 between William Mallory of the first part, of the County of Southampton & State of Va. James H. Williamson of the same part of the County of Greensville, and Coover James W. J. Parsons & Co. Nathans Parsons Coor. of S. R. Strong) and Paul & Pegram, Hunt, Patterson & Mills and all other just creditors of the said Mallory of the then part, Whereas the said William Mallory is justly indebted to Coover James W. J. in the sum of \$2363 1/100 to be paid on the 15. July 1838, due by bond and 362 2/100 due by bond, bearing date the 8th Decr. 1837, on demand 4 months after date - subject credits as will appear from the bonds, and to S. Parsons & Co in the sum of \$1153 09/100, dated the 2nd day of May 1836 and on demand the 20th day of Janry 1836, sub. ject to sundry credits as will appear from the bond and one bond for \$1637 6/100 three months after date, the first day of August 1836 and Nathans Parson Coor. of S. R. Strong) and in the sum of fifty eight dollars & 77/100 bearing date 21st day of Feby. 1837 & due six months after date, and S. Parsons and a/s which is filed in the Clerk's Office of Southampton & of all other just creditors their amounts not rec'd. The said Mallory being desirous and willing) to secure of his just creditors from this indenture, that for & in consideration of the promises and also for the further sum of one dollar to the said Mallory in hand paid by the said Williamson at & before the sealing of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said Mallory hath given, granted, bargained & sold unto the said Williamson his heirs and assigns forever two lots and appurtenances lying in the town of Petersburg, one home & Gosney, hogs, hens, sheep, the number not rec'd. but it is intended all belonging to the said Mallory house hold & kitchen furniture of every kind and description, plantation tools tools of every kind for the good use of year, goods wares & merchandise of all kinds of description all his outstancy, debts and their estate both real and personal and all my interests in my Father's estate with all & singular the appurtenances to the said lots and all the estate right title & interests of the said Mallory in & to the said granted or intended to be hereby granted. To have and to hold the said property both real and personal of every kind power to the only proper use of the sa James H. Williamson his heirs & assigns with hereby covenants in manner & form following), that is to say, That the said Mallory his heirs & assigns all the real & personal hereby conveyed unto the said James H. Williamson shall & well warrant & defend by their presents. Upon trust nevertheless that the sa James H. Williamson his heirs executors & assigns shall permit the said Mallory to remain in peaceable possession of the personal property unto the first day of October next and the said Mallory shall satisfy the aforesaid debts, before the first day of October, this deed shall be void but if the said Mallory should not satisfy the aforesaid debts, then the said James H. Williamson shall advertise and sell for cash the money all the property conveyed by the said deed after giving ten day notice of the time and place of sale and pay off the said debts and of any balance pay over to the said Mallory, and if the said Mallory should not pay off the debts aforesaid, as aforesaid the this deed to remain in full force and Virtue.
