This Indenture made and entered into on this 21st day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight between Boyd Sumner and Nancy his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and William Gardner of the same county and state of the other part his nephew. That the said Boyd Sumner and Nancy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty seven dollars current money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said William Gardner as before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do, and each of them with grants, bargains, sells, enfeoffs and confirm unto the said William Gardner his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Notteaway containing by a late survey forty nine acres (be the same more or less) and bounded as follows, to wit, beginning at a corner for said William Gardner and John Dorens dist. also a new corner for William Griffin, thence along said line from Griffins line N. 41° W. 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ poles to a corner on Robert Rich's line on the road, thence along the road N. 26° E. 33 poles thence N. 17° E. 18 poles, thence N. 24° E. 8 poles, thence N. 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 30 poles, thence N. 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 67 $\frac{1}{2}$ poles to a black gum a corner for Jeptha Pepe on said Robert Rich's line thence along said Pepe's line down the run a large branch to a corner for Arthur Gardner, thence along his line N. 32° W. 26 poles to a pine, thence N. 31° E. 12 poles to a Maple a corner for said Arthur Gardner thence N. 38° W. 7 poles to a black gum thence N. 39° W. 11 poles to a black gum thence N. 44° W. 18 poles to a large pine thence N. 46° W. 79 poles to the beginning together with all rights, title, interest, claim or demands of in and to the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and promises with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and promises with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said William Gardner his heirs and assigns forever. and the said Boyd Sumner and Nancy his wife for themselves their heirs executors execs &c with hereby commands and agrees to and with the said William Gardner his heirs executors execs &c assign that they may by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and promises and every part thereof, against the claims or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever.
