This Indenture made this day of in the year of our Lord One Thousand eight hundred and thirty seven between Allen Stephenson & John Gaultney Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Southampton to sell the land which Jefre Stephenson late of said County, deceased and of his wife of the said party and Leolin I. Stephenson of the other party witnesseth that the said Commissioners for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred & sixty five dollars to them in hand paid or received to be paid by the said Leolin I. Stephenson, at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Leolin I. Stephenson, all that tract or parcel of land which the said Jefre Stephenson did seize and of his wife of the said County of Southampton, and containing two hundred & forty acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Elias Summerville, Isham Jordan and Joel Porfey together with all and singular the premises and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold the said land with its appurtenances hereditaments, all and singular the premises and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights, member and appendage whatsoever belonging to the said Leolin I. Stephenson his heirs and assigns forever, free from the claims or demands of them, the said Commissioners or either of them their heirs and assigns forever, and of all and every person or persons whatsoever claiming from, by or through them, as commissioners, as aforesaid, shall will, do hereby warrant and forever defend unto the said Leolin I. Stephenson, all the right title and interest in them as Commissioners and no more, by these presents. This Indenture made This 17th day of June in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven between Leolin I. Stephenson of the County of Southampton of the one party and Stephen H. Washington of Southampton of the other party. Witnesseth that the said Leolin I. Stephenson in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars, current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Stephen H. Washington, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has bargained & sold unto the said Stephen H. Washington his heirs or assigns all his right title and interest in a tract of land lying in Southampton County being a part of the tract of land that Leolin had purchased of Bartholomew Lightfoot, bound in the following manner to wit by the lands of Joel Porfey beginning at the main Road, by running along said Porfey's line to Beavertown Swamp & down said swamp to Elias Summerville's line, then turning thence along said Summerville's line up to the lands of the late John Stephenson to the place where he keeps his main Roads, then so down the said Road to the first station with the Woods & all the appurtenances thereto containing Three Hundred acres more or less: also a tract of Land which Jefre Stephenson did seize and of his wife of the said County of Southampton containing two hundred & seventeen acres more or less bounded by the lands of Elias Summerville, Isham Jordan, Peter, Fletcher and Joel Porfey together with all and singular the premises thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all the right title and interest in the above named pieces of Land of the said Leolin I. Stephenson in the forenamed unto the said Stephen H. Washington his heirs & assigns forever, free from the claims of him the said Leolin I. Stephenson or his heirs or any person under him.
