This Indenture made and entered into this 2nd day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight, Between Nelson H. Hoages of the county of Southampton & State of Virginia of the first part, Jas. Magch of the aforesaid County and State of the second part, and Lafayette Bourne of the County of Marion State of North Carolina of the third part: Whereas the said Nelson H. Hoages stands justly indebted to the said Lafayette Bourne by three several bonds bearing date the 2nd day of May 1838 one for the sum of eighty hundred and forty four dollars forty four and a half cents payable the 1st day of January 1839 with interest from the first of February 1838 one other Bond bearing equal date for the sum of eighty hundred and forty four dollars and fifty four and a half cents payable on the 1st day of January 1840 with interest from the first day of February 1838, and one other Bond bearing equal date for the sum of eighty hundred and forty four dollars and fifty four and a half cents payable on the 1st day of Janry. 1841 with interest from the aforesaid first of February 1838 and which debts together with the interest accruing thereon ~~are due and owing~~ ^{with the interest}, ~~and~~ ^{the} the undersigned the promises, the said Nelson H. Hoages is willing and desirous to secure: now This Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and for the further considerations of the sum of one dollar of lawful money to the said Nelson H. Hoages in hand paid by the said James Magch, at and before the ensuing sales and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Nelson H. Hoages hath given, granted, conveyed, aliened, released and confirmed, and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain and sell, convey, release and confirm to the said James Magch, his heirs and assigns forever all the several tracts or parcels of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia on the S.W. side of Nottingham River and adjoining the town of Monroel containing five hundred and eighty four acres, more or less bounded by said Nottingham River from Monroel to the lands formerly belonging to the late Wm. Allen, thence along Allen's line a Waterway course to a corner in said Allen's line, for the lands of the aforesaid Lafayette Bourne thence along said Bourne line an easterly course to Monroel, all of which will more fully appear by reference to a Deed from the said Lafayette Bourne & Wife to said Nelson H.
