This Indenture made and entered into the fourteenth day of April one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight between Mesh Tyones & Permelly his wife of County of Barten State of North Carolina of the one part and Jordan Sperry of the County of Southampton State of Virginia of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Mesh Tyones and Permelly his wife for and in consideration sum of two hundred dollars lawful money of this commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Jordan Sperry at or before the sealing or delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained & sold and by these presents do and each of them bargain & sell unto the said Jordan Sperry his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing by estimation Eighty three acres be the same more or less & bounded as follows, beginning at a spine, a corner tree on the old line joining of Mr. Bowden and Nancy Bowden and thence a straight line on the road side to a spine a corner tree of Nancy Barroth adjoining Rich Adams and thence to spine corner tree adjoining R. Adams and thence a straight line to a Dog wood a corner tree adjoining R. Adams but formerly Wright and from thence to a sassafras a corner adjoining Mesh Tyones and thence a direct line to a Sycamore a corner tree adjoining Livingston Brith and said old line to a spine a corner tree adjoining of Bransards Brith and thence over the old line to the spine, a corner, as aforesaid; together with said lands, woods, waters, courses, privileges, profits, commodities, advantages, appurtenances, whatsoever to the said tract or parcel of land belonging or appertaining or with the same used or enjoyed taken or known and every part or parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract of land with hereditaments and all and singular parts and parts herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained & sold, with every right title & appurtenance of the said land unto the said Jordan Sperry his heirs & assigns forever to and for the only good use of the said Jordan Sperry his heirs & assigns forever: and the said Mesh Tyones and Permelly his wife do for themselves, their heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Mesh Tyones & Permelly his wife or either of them their heirs and assigns: and the said Mesh Tyones & Permelly his wife do by these presents warrant and defend the right and title of the said land and from any other person or persons claiming the said land or any part or parcel thereof.
