This Indenture made and entered into this 11th day of June in the year 1838 between Thomas L. Jones and Martha his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and William White of the same County of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Thomas L. Jones and Martha his wife for and in consideration of the sum of twelve hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said William White at or before the enrolling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said William White his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land, containing one hundred and sixty acres, be the same more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton being the tract of land which the said Thomas L. Jones (purchasee of Benjamin Drury & wife) was bounden as follows viz. Beginning at a corner tree standing in Charles Butler's land thence down the Mingo Branch to Holloway Swamp in James Scott's Mill pond to a corner, thence a line of marked trees to a corner standing in the meadow branch, thence said corner tree is the corner of Henry Gurley's land, and the said Thomas L. Jones thence a line of marked trees to the beginning, which said land divides between the said Thomas L. Jones and the heirs of Henry Gurley decd. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said William White his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said William White his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Thomas L. Jones and Martha his wife hereby warrant and agree to and with the said William White his heirs and assigns that they the said Thomas L. Jones & Martha his wife, will warrant and defend the aforesaid tract or parcel of land with its appurtenances unto the said William White his heirs and assigns, against themselves the said Thomas L. Jones and Martha his wife and their heirs and against all persons whomsoever. In Witness whereof the said Thomas L.
