Jones and Martha his wife for and in consideration of the sum of twelve hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said William White at or before the recording and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said William White his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land, containing One hundred and fifty acres, to the same more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton being the tract of land which the said Thomas L. Jones purchased of Benjamin Devany & wife and bounded as follows Wwp. Beginning at a corner tree standing in Charles Butts' line thence down the Shady Branch to Notaway Swamp at James Halls Mill pond to a corner, thence a line of marker trees to a corner standing in the meadow branch. The said corner tree is the corner of Henry Burley and. and the said Thomas L. Jones - thence a line of marker trees to the beginning, which said line divides between the said Thomas L. Jones and the heirs of Henry Burley and. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said William White his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said William White his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Thomas L. Jones and Martha his wife hereby covenants and agrees to and with the said William White his heirs and assigns that they the said Thomas L.
