This Indenture made and entered into on this 24th day of April in the year four and eighteen hundred and thirty eight between Josiah Morrill of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Lewis Wick of the same County and State of the other part, Witnesseth That the said Josiah Morrill for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars current money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said Lewis Wick at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeof and confirm unto him the said Lewis Wick his heirs and assigns forever the ten following Tracts or parcels of Land and premises, situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton & parish of Elizabeth containing by late survey three hundred acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit: The first Tract, beginning at a corner for Ann Story in said Lewis Wick's line thence along said Story's line N 30° W 138 poles to a corner in William Boygants line thence along his line N 83 1/2° E 43 poles to a red oak thence S 48 1/2° E 12 poles to a Dutch gum, thence along said Wick's line S 58° E 117 poles to a corner for S. Wick thence along his line S 47 1/2° W 73 poles to the beginning and also the two above mentioned Tracts or parcels of Land bounded as follows to wit: beginning at a Hickory at corner for said Wick thence N 47 1/2° E 14 poles to a post at corner for Ann Story thence along her line N 33 1/2° W 146 poles to a corner thence N 32° E 34 poles to a pine stump at corner for William Boygants thence along his line of marked trees N 31° E 16 1/2 poles to a lightwood post at corner thence N 37° W 58 poles to a lightwood post, thence S 75° W 135 poles to two whiteberry bushes and post standing in the spring branch at corner for the said same William Boygants in Henry Kindred line thence along his line N 13° W 5 poles to a pine thence N 79° W 21 poles to a dead poplar, thence S 84° W 12 poles to a pine thence S 58° W 14 poles to a pine thence S 63° W 6 poles to a black gum thence S 71 1/2° W 18 poles to a corner in the spring branch thence down the various courses of the run of said spring branch 298 poles to an oak stump standing on the N. M. side of said branch a corner in Cook's line thence along said Cook's line to a black gum at corner formerly for Lewis Morrill & Nicholas Boygants in a look's line thence along the line formerly between said Lewis Morrill & Nicholas Boygants to a pine another corner in said Morrill's line thence along said Morrill's line to a bunch of hays in the little mill another corner in said Morrill's line thence along said line to a lightwood post, a corner formerly for Sam Wick in S. Morrill's line thence along said Sam Wick's line to the beginning together with all rights title interests claim or demand of in and to the above described two Tracts or parcels of Land and premises with their appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to, and to hold the aforesaid two Tracts or parcels of Land and premises with all and singular their appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said Lewis Wick his heirs and assigns forever. To and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Lewis Wick his heirs and assigns forever and the said Josiah Morrill for himself, his heirs Exors. admors. &c. hereby covenant and agree to pay unto the said Lewis Wick his heirs Exors. admors. and assigns That he will by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title aforesaid two Tracts or parcels of Land and premises and every part and parcel thereof against the claim or demand of all and every person or persons whatsoever.
