This Indenture made and witnessed unto on this first day of January in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and thirty eight between Augustin Pope, of the County of Southampton and State of New York, of the one part and James Morell Junr. of the same County & State of the other part, witnesseth that the said Augustin Pope for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and ninety two dollars fifty cents money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said James Morell Junr. at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff & confirm unto him the said James Morell Junr. his heirs and assigns forever certain Tracts or parcels of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County & State and in Southwicks parish on called the Parton tract containing by estimation of twenty five and 1/4 acres of land, to the same more or less and bounded as followeth beginning at a weedy gorse standing in the Moaffit branch a corner in Belling Barnes' line near the head of said branch thence down the run of said branch to the first spring of said branch then up the spring of said branch to a pine standing in the head of a small pond or corner of Allen Beale's land thence up said branch to a post oak in the head of S. James Morell Junr. line or corner of said pond of this tract of land thence a straight line of sd Barnes to the beginning; the other tract of land called the Peul tract adjoining the above mentioned tract by an estimation of thirty nine and 1/2 acres be the same more or less and bounded as followeth beginning at the said corner (post oak of said Barnes' line) and thence in sd. James Morell Junr. line thence sd. Morell's line by the well known marked trees to a small dogwood a corner tree thence a long in Morell's line near as North West (corner to a pine at corner tree standing) near sd Morell's house, of Henry for ever and Allen Beale's land thence a straight line of said Beale's to a pine standing in sd. pond or half of sd. pond line in the spring of said Moaffit branch thence up said branch to the beginning, which two parcels of land make Sixty five acres, by estimation be the same more or less together with all and singular its appurtenances belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto the premises to have and to hold all the right, title, interest, &c of him the said Augustin Pope of and to the aforesaid two tracts of land & premises unto the said James Morell Junr. his heirs & assigns forever.
