Murphy and William Gibell, Gibel and Simmonds and Jeppe Little with all and singular the appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of land belonging or in any wise appertaining) and all the estate right title and interest of the said Benjamin Simmonds, in and to the said granted or intended to be hereby granted tract or parcel of land & premises, to have and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances hereby conveyed unto the said Edwards Butts his heirs executors, execs. and assigns forever to the only use and behoof of the said Edwards Butts his heirs execs. admrs. and assigns forever, and the said Benjamin Simmonds for himself, his heirs execs. and admrs. shall hereby warrant, promise and agree to and with the said Edwards Butts his heirs execs. execs. and assigns forever in manner and form following: That is to say that the said Benjamin Simmonds his heirs execs. administrators the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises with their appurtenances hereby conveyed unto the said Edwards Butts his heirs, execs. execs. and assigns, against all persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents. Upon trust, nevertheless that the said Edwards Butts his heirs execs. admrs. shall permit the said Benjamin Simmonds to remain in quiet possession of the said tract or parcels of land, until default be made in the payment of the said sum of eighty one dollars thirty two cents with the interest, that may grow due thereon either in whole or in part and then upon the further trust that he his heirs execs. admrs. or assigns shall and will, so soon after the happening of such default of payment may think proper or either of the parties may request sell the tract or parcels of land or such interest as the said Benjamin Simmonds may have in said premises to the highest bidder for ready money, giving at least ten days notice of the time and place of sale, at least three public places and the money arising from such sale pay and satisfy cost and charges attending this trust, then the sum of eighty one dollars and thirty two cents with the interest, that may grow due thereon, then the balance if any, pay over to the said Benjamin Simmonds or such person as he may in writing authorise to receive the same. Barley in several sum of money as will be more particularly set forth and being anxious to secure and provide for the payment of the same, as well as in consideration of five dollars to him in hand paid by the said James S. French at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, in order first to secure a bond due May 21st 1838 for the sum of one hundred and thirty seven dollars to the said Harry Joyner hath granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents with grants, bargains, sell and convey unto James S. French his heirs and assigns forever the following property, to wit, all the interest which he the said Harry Joyner has in a deed of trust dated June 22nd 1837 in which he the said Harry Joyner conveys to S. R. Edwards for the sum
