This Indenture made this fifth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight, between John Moore of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part, James Smith of said County and State of the second part and Thomas Johnson of said County and State of the third part: Whereas the said Thomas Johnson by his deed dated the fifteenth day of January one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight and admitted to record in the County Court of Southampton on the day of one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight in order to secure the payment of a sum of money due James Smith by bond, the said Thomas Johnson conveyed in trust to the said John Moore a certain tract of land lying & being in said County and containing one hundred and fifty acres more or less and the said sum of money having been fully paid by the said Thomas Johnson to the said James Smith, he the said Thomas Johnson hath requested that the said estate conveyed by the said deed of trust to the said John Moore in the said bond be now released to him the said Thomas Johnson. This Indenture therefore witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and also for and in consideration of one dollar by the said Thomas Johnson to the said John Moore in hand paid before the signing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John Moore with the consent of the said James Smith signified by his being a party thereto have granted, remised, released and forever quit claimed and by these do fully and absolutely grant, remise, release and forever quit claim unto the said Thomas Johnson his heirs and assigns forever, all the estate, right, title interest, property claim and claims whatsoever in law and equity of him the said John Moore of in and unto the aforesaid lot of ground with the appurtenances. To have and to hold the said lot of land with the appurtenances to the said Thomas Johnson his heirs and assigns forever so that the said John Moore his heirs or assigns nor any person whatsoever claiming under him shall by any ways or means hereafter have a claim, challenge or demand, any estate right title or interest of in or to the said premises or any part or parcel thereof, but from all and every action suits or any part thereof, he the said John Moore shall utterly excluded and barred forever, by these presents.
