This Indenture

made and entered into this 3rd day of March in the year of our Lord 1838 between Monroe Clements trustee of the first part, Samuel B Boykin of the second part, and Hamilton Coffey attorney for John Livezey of the third part; Whereas the said Samuel B Boykin on the 28th day of Novr 1831 in order to secure the payment of the sum of four hundred dollars to the said John Livezey and by Indenture of trust of that date conveyed to the said Monroe Clements his heirs execs. &c. one tract or parcel of land (lying and being) in the County of Southampton in the state of Virginia (and containing) by estimation four hundred, eleven acres, and bounded by the lands of John Brown John Mozulark and Joshua Dreyer, upon trust for the use and purposes in the said Indenture mentioned and whereas since the execution and delivery of the said deed of trust the said Samuel B Boykin hath this day paid the sum of two hundred dollars to the said Hamilton Coffey as agent or attorney for said John Livezey which the said Hamilton Coffey doth hereby acknowledge. Now this Indenture therefore witnesseth that for the consideration aforesaid as well as for the further sum of one dollar in hand paid by the said Samuel B Boykin to the said Monroe Clements at and before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Monroe Clements with the agent, and approbation of the said Hamilton Coffey agent as aforesaid, signified by his being party to these presents, and the said Hamilton Coffey have granted bargained & sold (and by his being party to these presents, and the said Hamilton Coffey have granted bargained & sold and confirmed and confirmed and by these presents, as grant, bargain & sell, remise, release and confirm unto the said Samuel B Boykin all the estate right title interest claim and demand both at law and in equity which the said Monroe Clements have or hold in trust honor and favor of the said John Livezey, to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land to wit the part of said land hereby released is contained in the following bounds (to wit) commencing at a pine tree nearly North thence a line of marked trees to a pine nearly south which is a dividing line between Isham Jordan and the balance of the land which is under the deed to the aforesaid John Livezey; to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land to wit one half the whole tract, be the same more or less (lying in the last mentioned bounds, to the said Samuel B Boykin his heirs executors, admors. and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said John Livezey; and the said Samuel B Boykin his heirs executors, admors. and assigns forever and the said Monroe Clements & Hamilton Coffey for themselves their executors and admors. the above mentioned land which is in the last mentioned bounds unto the said Samuel B Boykin his heirs executors, admors. and assigns in as full and ample a manner as this same was warranted by the said Samuel B Boykin by the deed of trust above recited, as warrant the same to the said Samuel B Boykin against the claim or claims of them the
