This Indenture made this twenty fifth day of June A.D. 1838 between Richard C. Williams
and Jonah B. Williams of the state of Kentucky, by John Moore their attorney, of the one party, and Jepé
Drewry of the other party, the two last of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that
the said Richard C. Williams & Jonah B. Williams, by the said John Moore their attorney, for and in consider-
ation of the sum of Three hundred and Twenty five dollars in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
ledged, have granted bargained and sold unto the said Jepé Drewry his heirs and assigns forever the following
tracts of land lying and being in the County of Southampton, the one tract containing by recent
survey two hundred and thirty seven acres, and bounded as follows beginning at a gum in a branch near the said
Suffield Road and running along a line of marked trees, which separates it from the lands of said
Jepé Drewry, South 5° East, to a branch which leads into Mapenburg's Mill from whence along the said
branch to said Mill Pond, thence along the line in said Pond to the mouth of Flagg's Run, whence up said
Flagg's Run to the mouth of the first named branch thence up the same to the beginning. The other tract or piece
of land adjoins the last mentioned tract and is bounded on the south by the last mentioned branch, on the
east by State path on the North by the said Road and on the West by said Flagg's Run and contains about
fifteen acres (more or less) together with the revisions and remainders and all the estates, rights, titles inti-
tled or claimed of the said Richard C. Williams and Jonah B. Williams or either of them in and to the said
tracts of land and every part thereof to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Jepé Drewry his
heirs and assigns forever. To have and to hold the said tracts of land and promises and every part thereof
to him the said Jepé Drewry his heirs and assigns forever. Another said Richard C. Williams & Jonah B. Williams
by John Moore their attorney, do hereby warrant and defend the rights and titles of the said land
and promises against themselves and their heirs and those claiming under them unagainst all and every
other person whatsoever. In witness whereof the said Richard C. Williams & Jonah B. Williams, by John
Moore, their attorney have hereunto set their hand and seal the day and year above mentioned.

This Indenture, made this fifth day of June, in the year of Christ, One thousand eight hundred
and thirty eight, between Thomas Johnson of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one party
and Harrison D. Moore of said County of the other party - Witnesseth, that the said Thomas Johnson for and in con-
sideration of the sum of six hundred dollars current money of Virginia to him by the said Harrison D. Moore
in hand paid the receipt whereof the said Thomas Johnson doth hereby acknowledge both granted bargain-
ed, sold and conveyed, and by these presents doth grant, bargain sell and convey unto the said Harrison D. Moore,
his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred and fifty acres more or
less lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows, beginning at a corner where
said tract lies between Jeremiah Millford and said Johnson thence a line of marked trees on Millford's line to a corner
between Whitehead and Millford thence a line of marked trees on Samuel Mallard's line to an ash tree at
corner between said Johnson Mallard & others thence a line of marked trees on Thomas G. Jones and Jas.
H. Schell's line formerly of Muddill's. to a lightwood stump a corner in said Jones & Schell's line thence
a line of marked trees on said Jones & Schell's line to the beginning a reference to three seeds from
Johnson to Jones & from Jones to Tugrants, from Tugrants to Johnson, will show the boundary of
said land and quantity of acres, to have and to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances thereto
belonging to him the said Harrison D. Moore his heirs and assigns, to the only proper use and behoof of the
said Harrison D. Moore his heirs and assigns forever. Another said Thomas Johnson for himself, his heirs,
executors and administrators doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Harrison D. Moore his heirs and
assigns that he the said Thomas Johnson and his heirs, the said tract or parcel of land, with appurtenances, are
to him the said Harrison D. Moore his heirs and assigns against him the said Thomas Johnson, and his heirs
