This Indenture made the thirtieth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight between Randolph R. Gardner of the County of Southampton of the first party witness Dr. Jones and Adolphus H. Jones of the County of Newcomb of the second party and Jeptha Gardner of Gardner's trustees aforesaid County of Southampton of the third party. Whereas the said Jeptha Gardner stands as security for the said Randolph R. Gardner for the guardianship of Eliza McLawson & Margaret A. Garrison orphans of Jeremiah Gardner deceased which the said Randolph R. Gardner is willing and desires to

accrue, as joint obligor aforesaid. Now This Indenture further witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of one dollar to the said Randolph R. Gardner in hand paid by the said William M. Jones and Adolphus H. Jones at or before the concluding and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) he the said Randolph R. Gardner hath given granted bargained sold alienated enfeoffed released and confirmed and by these presents hath given grants bargains alienated enfeoffed released and confirm unto the said William M. Jones & Adolphus H. Jones a certain tract of land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton adjoining the lands of Jeptha Parker Mrs. McLawson & the heirs of John Cobb and others containing Seventy five acres be the same more or less, also in
many other all my stocks of hogs and cattle one horse all my household and kitchen furniture of
very description (including) my beds and furniture and also the crop of corn fedder (feed & manure
any more growing) and which may hereafter grow, together with all and singular the appurtenances to the said
tract or parcel of land belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold the aforesaid hereby given
or intended to be granted tract or parcel of land with its appurtenances, together with the personal pro-
perty and stock conveyed unto the said William M. Jones & Adolphus H. Jones their heirs executors
administrators and assigns forever upon trust. Nevertheless that the said William M. Jones and Adolphus
H. Jones shall as soon as they conveniently can after the first day of January next ensuing, make known
noticed by writing from the said Jeptha Gardner, proceed to advertise the place and time of sale of the
land aforesaid and other property by three several advertisements one of which shall be preceding the east of the
front house of said County on some one County day previous to the day of sale, then proceed to sell the same
to the highest bidder for ready money and out of the monies arising from such sale first pay and re-
tire all necessary expenses attending the sale, and then pay to the said Jeptha Gardner the debt aforesaid
with lawful interest thereon accruing from the time the same becomes due until paid, and the balance of the
monies (if any) then the said William M. Jones & Adolphus H. Jones shall pay to the said Randolph R.
Gardner or to his heirs or assigns on demand. But if the said Randolph R. Gardner shall pay off and satisfy
the whole of the sum due to the orphans of the said Jeremiah Gardner as soon as they shall demand
the same. Then this indenture to be null and void and of no effect otherwise to be and remain in full
