delivery of these presents, has granted bargained and sold, and by these presents does grant, bargain and sell
unto the said Mark T Peete his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying on Blunt's
Swamp, in the County of Southampton, containing by estimation Six hundred thirty eight acres (be the
same more or less) which was devised to the said George Blunt by the last Will and Testament of Benjamin
Blunt decd. his father, and which said land adjoins the lands of Brury Butte and Thos. - A more full
particular description of said tract of land may be seen by reference to the report of the Commissioners who
ran the line between this tract and the land devised to Dr Benj. B. Blunt, agreeable to the directions
of the Will of said Benj. Blunt decd. together with all and singular the reversions & remainders and the
rights and profits thereof, and every part and parcel thereof, unto the said Mark T Peete his heirs and assigns
forever, to the only proper use and behoof of them the said Mark T Peete and his heirs and assigns forever.
And the said George Blunt, for himself, his heirs and assigns, does hereby warrant and forever defend the

of whom reside in the County of Southampton & State of Virginia. This indenture witnesseth that the said
Harrison Pope has for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred and fifty dollars to him in hand
paid by the said Benjamin Phillips at and before the execution and delivery of these presents the receipt of
which is acknowledged by the said Harrison Pope have therefore, hereby granted, bargained and sold unto
the said Benjamin Phillips a certain tract & parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County
of Southampton called and known by the name of Buckland and adjoining the lands of the following
named persons to wit, Lafayette Brown, Benjamin Whitfield & John E. Brier, and supposed to contain
two hundred acres of land more or less. To have and to hold the said above described land and every part
and parcel thereof, together with the emoluments and appurtenances to the said land belonging with all
the said land adjoining, with all the right title interests and Estate which he the said Harrison Pope
has heretofore had held and enjoyed in and to the said land to him the said Benjamin Phillips his heirs
and assigns forever, free from the claim of him the said Harrison Pope his heirs and assigns and also
free from the claim of all & every Person & persons whomsoever with and so therefore warrant the
