Milton Mellons and William Sping Esq. of the aforesaid County, and for further consideration of the natural regard we  
have for the prosperity of the cause of Religion and the benefit of the Citizens of the neighbourhood, the above named parties  
have granted bargained & sold & do by these presents grant bargain sell and confirm unto the above named Trustees  
and their successors for the benefit of the regular Baptists Church of Christ at Milfield, a certain piece of land  
situated on the said meeting house containing by estimation one & half acres more or less marked as follows com-  
mencing at a pine tree at the north east corner of the House, <sup>thence</sup> along a line of marked trees to a oak tree to  
the spalled Road down said Road to a corner pine tree thence along a line of marked trees to a pine tree  
tree on the south east corner thence to the first station, the said land was a part of the lands formerly belonging  
to (Capt. Richard Kells and Sping) and being in the aforesaid County To have and to hold the said land to the  
said Trustees & their successors, to their proper use of the Baptists Church of Christ forever. And the said parties  
Richard A. Kells, William Kells and John Boykin do hereby further covenant, and agree to and with the said  
Trustees) Shugars Lains and their that this present deed of bargain & sale shall be to them and their successors  
forever, as good & sufficient warranty against them & all claiming by them or under them as well as

This Indenture made and entered into on the fifth day of April in the year of our Lord eighteen  
hundred and thirty eight between Nancy Magez of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the  
one part and John Margourd of the same County and State of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Nancy  
Magez, trustee to a Deed of Trust, executed to him by William Joyner and Vienna his Wife of said County  
for certain purposes therein mentioned, bearing date on the 18th day of April Eighteen hundred and thirty eight  
and duly recorded in the Clerks Office in said County of Southampton whereby they the said William Joyner  
and Vienna his Wife conveyed to him the said Nancy Magez (in trust) a certain tract or parcel of land  
and premises (situate) lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Saint Lukes  
containing by survey one hundred and six & half acres be the same more or less and bounded by the  
lands of said John Margourd, Jacob Jordan, Christian Jordan and others. The said Nancy Magez by  
Notice of the provisions of the aforesaid deed of trust, (at the request of Jacob Jordan one of the aforesaid  
parties therein mentioned) duly advertised the time and place of sale as required of him by the aforesaid deed  
of trust and on the above day and date at public auction all of the said tract or parcel of land and  
premises conveyed in said deed of trust and the said John Margourd became the purchaser thereof for  
the sum of seven hundred and eighty <sup>one</sup> dollars & fifty cents, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged  
for which consideration he the said Nancy Magez doth hereby convey to him the said John Margourd his  
heirs and assigns forever all the right, title and interest, to the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises
