Memorandum of a contract made & entered into this thirtieth day of March in the year 1838 between  
John A. Person of the County of Southampton & Mary C. Matthews of the County of Greensville & both of the  
State of Virginia. Whereas Marriage is shortly intended to be had and solemnized by Divine permission,  
by and between the said John A. Person of the said Mary C. Matthews and whereas it is distinctly understood  
it is agreed between the contracting parties, that neither of them shall, by the Marriage which is intended to  
be had, acquire any right title or claim whatever to the property of the other - but the same shall be-  
come unaffected thereby & remain in such plights & condition as if the said Marriage should never take  
place. Now these presents are therefore to witness that the said John A. Person will not affect or maintain  
any claim or right or title to any property which the said Mary C. Matthews has, or may have or acquire  
during the marriage, nor shall the said John A. Person alien, or incur any expense of the sum in any man-  
ner, but the same shall be entirely subject to the control & disposition of the said Mary C. Matthews in such  
manner as she may think proper by her last will and testament or otherwise. And the said Mary C. Mat-  
thews in consideration of the above relinquishment on the part of the said John A. Person doth hereby covenant &  
agree that in case she should after the said intended marriage have, happen to survive the said John A.  
Person that she should not, have or claim any part of the real or personal or mixed estate whereof the said  
John A. Person should be seized or possessed or entitled unto at any time during the continuance between them,  
by virtue of her donee or title of owner by Common Law or Statute or as her undistributable share or by virtue  
of her being administrator or entitled to administration of the goods & chattels rights & credits of the said  
John A. Person or otherwise however. And it is further agreed between these contracting parties that  
should there be any issue of their Marriage & any or all of them should die and in such case as the  
said Mary C. Matthews would be entitled as heir or distributed in the absence of this contract then the said  
Mary C. Matthews shall not have or affect any right or claim to the property of said decedent either or  
otherwise, but the same shall descend and pass in a course of distribution to the legal heirs and distributees of  
the said John A. Person. And the said Mary C. Matthews wholly depends upon such free & voluntary provision  
as the said John A. Person may choose or think proper to make for her, if any, by last will & testament or  
otherwise. In testimony whereof the contracting parties have hereunto affixed our seals & subscribe our
