This Indenture made this 28th day of July in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight between Jep Fulgham of the County of Nansemond of the one part and Hardy Chapman of Sleepwhite County of the other part witnesseth that the said Jep Fulgham for and in consideration of Fifty dollars to him in hand paid by the said Hardy Chapman at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Jep Fulgham who hath granted, bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Hardy Chapman his heirs and assigns all his right, title, interest, property, claim and demand, either in law or Equity, of, in, and to one certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton in the state of Virginia containing by estimation two hundred acres or there more or less and bounded by the lands of Richard & Houghwart Hills & Lawrence and John Boykin, and the main run of Black water river it being the same tract of land which was held by Jep Fulgham deceased (late of Sleepwhite County) in his will to his son Henry Fulgham who was the father of the said Jep Fulgham & who is a party to these presents. To have and to hold the said right title interest property claim and demand, of and in the said tract of land and all and singular the improvements and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Hardy Chapman his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Jep Fulgham for himself, his heirs executors and administrators, doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Hardy Chapman his heirs and assigns, that the said Jep Fulgham and his heirs the right title interest property claim and demand as well in law as Equity which he now Jep Fulgham has hereby conveyed, against him the said Jep Fulgham and his heirs and against all and every other person whomsoever unto the said Hardy Chapman his heirs and assigns shall and will by these presents forever warrant and defend.
