William's Exor. John C. Turner Executor of Matthias Williams deceased of the County of Southampton, Virginia  
of the one part and Robert Williams of the County of Bedford North Carolina of the other part  
Witness that the said John C. Turner Executor of Matthias Williams did for and in consideration  
of the sum of the same of Four hundred and fifty five dollars and forty cents lawful money of  
United States paid in hand by the said Robert Williams the receipt whereof the said John C. Turner  
Executor as aforesaid doth hereby acknowledge, hath granted bargained and sold and by this  
presents doth grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Robert Williams his heirs and assigns  
a certain tract or parcel of land of which Matthias Williams died seized and possessed  
which the said Matthias Williams by his last will and Testament directed to be divided  
among by late survey one hundred and sixty five acres to the same more or less bounded  
by the lands of Davis Bryant Edwin G Hart and others lying and being in the County  
of Southampton, To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the  
appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said Robert Williams his heirs and assigns  
the only proper use and behoof of the said Robert Williams his heirs and assigns  
and the said John C. Turner Executor as aforesaid and his heirs the said tract  
or parcel of land with the appurtenances unto the said Robert Williams his heirs
