Drake has become heir or beneficiary to the one fourth part of the undivided personal estate of Martha Drake dec^d. (Sister to the before mentioned Nancy S. Blythe) who died sometime about July last; and he the said Blythe being desirous to dispose of his said interest in said estate doth by these presents for and in consideration of the sum of twenty two dollars to him in hand paid by the said F. S. allahome at or before the executing and delivery of these presents bargain sell convey & confirm unto him the said F.
