This Indenture made this Twenty second day of May in the year of Christ one thousand eight hundred and
Thirty eight between Jesse Lankford of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and John
Moore of said County and State of the other part. Whereas a certain Deed conveyed by certain indenture bearing
date the twenty fifth day of January one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight and admitted to record
in the Court of Southampton County on the twenty first day of July one thousand eight hundred and twenty
eight did grant transfer and convey to the said Jesse Lankford his heirs or assigns all that tract or part
of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid containing one hundred and twenty one acres in the
same more or less and bounded by the established metes and bounds as mentioned in the deed from
Thomas Edwards and Wife to Sara Bowers and from Sara Bowers and wife to the said Jesse Lankford
as will appear by reference to those deeds all of which are of record in said County of Southampton
with all and singular the appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of Land belonging in any
wise appertaining in trust and with power and authority to the said Jesse Lankford his heirs
and assigns to sell and dispose of the said Land or so much thereof as might be necessary for
trust purposes in said deed expressed. And whereas the said Jesse Lankford in execution of the said
Trust the term place and terms of sale having been for twenty days previous thereto advertised
in the neighborhood of said lands and at the Courthouse door of said County on every Court
day expose to sale for ready money on the premises the said tract of Land and at which sale
the aforesaid John Moore being the highest bidder for said Land at the price of five hundred
and seventy dollars became the purchaser thereof and this Indenture Witnesseth that the
said Jesse Lankford in further execution of the Trust aforesaid and for and in consider-
ation of the sum of Four hundred and seventy dollars by the said John Moore to him a-
bandon to be by him applied in pursuance of the said Trust towards discharging such sum of
money as shall be due and owing from the said Deed conveyed to the said Sara Bowers with legal
interest thereon also the expenses attending the said Trust and the execution thereof have granted the
gained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said John Moore his
heirs and assigns the piece or parcel of Land herein before particularly described and which is
disposed of at public auction as aforesaid together with the appurtenances thereto belonging in
any wise appertaining. To have and to hold the said piece or parcel of Land together with its appurtenances
to the said John Moore his heirs and assigns to the only proper
said piece or parcel of Land hereby conveyed together with its appurtenances to the said John
Moore his heirs and assigns against the claim of the said Jesse Lankford and his heirs and
against all persons whomsoever claiming by through or under him by these presents well known
