Know all men by these presents that I James Beale of the County of Southampton, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty seven dollars and thirty seven cents to me in hand paid by Mary Beale of the said County and State hath bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Mary Beale all the right Title and interest to which I am or may be entitled at the death of the said Mary Beale by virtue of my intermarriage with her during the life of said Mary and their children and the other property owned by said Mary Beale to her wife the said Mary and their children during the life of her the said Mary by a certain deed bearing date the 26th day of October and recorded in the County Court of Southampton County on the 19th day of November 1838. To have and to hold the interest hereby conveyed unto the said Mary Beale her heirs or assigns against the claims of myself the said James Beale and of all and every third person or persons whatsoever. This Indenture made and executed this day of 1839 one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine
between James Edwards and Martha his wife on part and Spikes Beale of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said James Edwards and Martha his wife for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to them in hand paid the said Spikes Beale which is hereby acknowledged and bargained and sold alienated and confirmed. And do by these presents bargain and sell alienate and confirm unto the said Spikes Beale his heirs and assigns forever. One certain tract of land lying and being in Southampton County containing by survey ten hundred and thirty one and one half acres more or less bounded as follows. Viz. On the North by lot of James Edwards lower land containing by deed of Edwards dec'd land Southwardly by Edward Edwards land and on the West by Edward Edwards land all being apart of Abigail Edwards dec'd tract of land. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract and parcel of land with every part and parcel thereof and things belonging thereto unto the said Spikes Beale his heirs and assigns forever and the reversion or reversions remain and shall remain unto the said James Edwards and Martha his wife do hereby warrant and forever defend the aforesaid premises from all the claims or claims demand or demands of them their heirs executors and administrators of all and every person whatsoever.
