consideration of the sum and full sum of one thousand dollars current money of the State of Virginia in hand
paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and the said Gray Edwards hath given granted bargained
and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said Gillum Edwards and to
his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land in Southampton County aforesaid which
James Edwards conveyed and confirmed to the aforesaid Gray Edwards by his deed bearing date
the 15th day of February one thousand eight hundred and thirty and is so record in the Clerks office
in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing by estimation one hundred and eighty four
acres and a half acre to be the same more or less with the reservation and reversions remainders and
remainder rents issues and profits thereof bounded by the known and ascertained bounds thereof to
have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all and every the appurtenances thereto
belonging unto the said Gillum Edwards his heirs and assigns to the only proprie of and ship
of the said Gillum Edwards his heirs and assigns forever and the said Gray Edwards his heirs
executors and administrators the said tract or parcel of land with all and every the appurtenances
thereto belonging unto the said Gillum Edwards his heirs and assigns shall and

This Indenture made this 29th day of December in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred
and Thirty eight between Fielding Rose and Mary T Rose his wife of the County of Suffolk on the one part and
James Macklemore of the County of Southampton on the other part witnesseth that the said Fielding Rose
and Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred dollars to them in hand
paid or secured to be paid by the said James Macklemore the receipt of which is with the said Fielding
Rose and Mary his wife doth hereby confess and acknowledge have bargained and sold & confirmed
and doth by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said James Macklemore his
executors administrators and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate in
in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and bounded as follows commencing at
Rose's Swamp on the east thence down the meanderings of said swamp to Fielding line
thence along a public path to Fielding gate thence along the line of the lands belonging to
the estate of Capt. Newell Harris down to the road leading from said Harris to the Corp. keys a vein
Edward's line thence said Edwards line to the right branch touching Nathaniel Francis line to
the beginning containing four hundred eighty four and one fourth acres be the sum more or
less; with all and singular the rights privileges improvements and appurtenances of all kinds
whatsoever. The said tract or parcel of land to him the said James Macklemore his heirs
executors administrators and assigns forever and they the said Fielding Rose and Mary his wife
for themselves their heirs executors administrators and assigns doth covenant to and with the said
James Macklemore his heirs executors administrators and assigns that the said lands are free and clear
of all incumbrances whatsoever, and that they have good right full power and lawful authority to grant
and convey the same thereby warranting and defending the legal title thereof; not only against themselves
but also their heirs executors administrators and assigns but against the lawful claim or claims of every person or
