This Indenture made this 10th day of January one Thousand Eight hundred and Thirty three between Gray Edwards of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and William Edwards of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Gray Edwards for and in consideration of the just and full sum of one Thousand dollars Current money of the State of Virginia in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and the said Gray Edwards hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said William Edwards and to James Edwards conveyed and confirmed to the aforesaid Gray Edwards by his deed bearing date the 15th day of February one Thousand eight hundred and thirty, and it is record in the Clerk's office in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing by estimation one hundred and eighty four acres and shall more or less with the reversion and reversions remainder and remainder rents issues and profits thereof bounded by the known and specified bounds thereof To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all and every the appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said William Edwards his heirs and assigns To the only proper use and behoof of the said William Edwards his heirs and assigns forever and the said Gray Edwards his heirs Executors and administrators, the said tract or parcel of land with all and every the appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said William Edwards his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents. This Indenture made this 28th day of December in the year of our Lord Christ one Thousand Eight hundred and Thirty eight between Fielding Rose and Mary Jane his wife of the County of Sussex on the one part and James Macklamore of the County of Southampton on the other part Witnesseth that the said Fielding Rose and Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred dollars To them in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said James Macklamore the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the said Fielding Rose and Mary his wife doth hereby confess and acknowledge have bargained and sold & confirmed and doth by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said James Macklamore his Executors administrators and assigns forever. One certain tract or parcel of land situate in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and bounded as follows, commencing at Davis Swamp on the east, thence down the meadow wings of said Swamp to Fitzhugh's line thence along a public path to Fitzhugh's gate thence along the line of the lands belonging to the estate of Capt. Peter Harris son to the road leading from said Harris to the Corp. Key to John Edwards line thence ^{along} said Edwards line to the orange branch touching Nathaniel Francis line to the beginning. Containing four hundred eighty four and one fourth acres be the same more or less with all and singular the rights privileges improvements and appurtenances of all and every kind whatsoever. The said tract or parcel of land to have the said James Macklamore his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever and they the said Fielding Rose and Mary his wife for themselves their heirs Executors administrators and assigns doth covenant to and with the said James Macklamore his heirs Executors administrators and assigns that the said land is free and clear of all incumbrances whatsoever, and that they have good right full power and lawful authority to grant sell and convey the same hereby warranting and defending the legal title thereof not only against themselves but also against the heirs Executors administrators and assigns but against the lawful claim or claims of every person or persons whatsoever.
