This Indenture made this twenty first day of January one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine between William Lawrence of the first part and John B Lawrence of the second part both being in and of the County of Isle of White and State of Virginia. Witnesseth whereof that the said William Lawrence for and in consideration of the sum of Three thousand dollars to him in hand paid by the said John B Lawrence it and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said William Lawrence hath bargained granted and sold and by these presents doth bargain grant sell and convey unto the said John B Lawrence his heirs or assigns or to the use or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation eight hundred and eight acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows viz on the east and south by the main old road leading from black water bridge up to Nathans Lanes and South Lanes lines and the North by Black water and sea cock and on the west by the lands of William Stephenson Jeffrey Johnson Summers and others which said tract or parcel of land is known by the name of Simmons tract together with all its appurtenances singularly then to belong to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all its appurtenances unto the said John B Lawrence his heirs or assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said John B Lawrence for his Covenant promises and agrees to warrant and for ever to hold and title to the aforesaid or mentioned tract or parcel of land with all its appurtenances unto the said John B Lawrence his heirs or assigns forever against the claim and demand of the said William Lawrence his heirs or assigns and against all and every person whomsoever.
