This Indenture made the 19th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine between Harry Hatfield as to his wife right and William Hatfield and his wife Sally Hatfield as to their joint right of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and James Bowers of the same County and State of the other part witnesseth that the said Harry Hatfield William Hatfield and Sally Hatfield his wife in consideration of two hundred dollars good and lawful money to them and their said wife paid at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said James Bowers his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract of land situated lying and being in the County aforesaid on the Black Water river and containing by estimation one hundred and twenty five acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows (viz) by the lands of the said James Bowers by the Lanes of Johnsons bottom beginning at the mouth of the Cypress swamp where it empties into the Black water river near Gaynes bridge thence up said swamp to the mouth of Jacks branch thence up said branch to Bowers line thence along said line to the Cypress swamp thence along down said swamp to a gum standing on said Bowers line thence along the margin of the low grounds still bending on Bowers line to Black water River thence down said river to the mouth of said Cypress swamp the beginning together with all and singular the inclosure and reversions contained and remaining yearly and other rents issues and profits therefrom and of every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said one hundred and twenty five acres above mentioned with the tenements and all the hereditaments and appendages therin before mentioned annexed to be bargained and sold with every of their rights members and appendages attached to the said Harry Hatfield William Hatfield and Sally Hatfield his wife for themselves and their heirs the said one hundred and twenty five acres of land with all and singular the promises and appendages before mentioned made unto the said James Bowers his heirs and assigns free from the burdens or claims of them the said Harry Hatfield William Hatfield and Sally Hatfield his wife or either of them or either of their heirs and of all persons whatsoever shall well and truly warrant and convey the same by these presents. In witness whereof the said Harry Hatfield William Hatfield and Sally Hatfield his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written.
